3	Review Outstanding Action Items Stuart Jones	ACTION – John to create draft submission re development of Stromlo Forrest Park  Stu to speak with Neale Guthrie about plans for SFP, especially as increased costs to run road events (traffic control) has increased potential importance of a closed road circuit within SFP. ACTION CLOSED.  ACTION – Stu to raise the issue of responsibility for u15/u17 coaching with CACT at their next meeting.  CACT Meeting rescheduled until next week, although SJ has spoken with Adrian Marshall and there is currently no plan in place for coaching these riders and clubs are free to put something in place. It was discussed that the social aspect was important for riders of this age group and something that should be encouraged. Those riders looking for more serious development would be encouraged to join Cheryl's squad or similar programs. ACTION CLOSED
4	Presidents Report Stuart Jones	Traffic marshals an issue again with professional controllers needed, despite original decision from Sport & Rec, WorkSafe and EventsACT. No time to investgate options since receiving notification. CARE booked for Club Champs on weekend. Race Entry fee to be increased to \$10, and possibly more to cover costs.  CCC Team in National Captial Tour performed well, enjoyed it and took a lot away from the experience and opportunity. Some riders looking at taking part in more NRS events next year.  Membership fees - Stuart & Al away next week and unable to attend CACT Council Meeting, but other Committee Members will aim to attend. Keen to see fee increase kept to a minimum.  2014 Membership - once 2014 are available, letter to be sent to all members (and 2012's who didn't renew) highlighting what the club has achieved this year. 		Equipment Officer - Peter Gough     Nothing to report.
		GSIC and Junior Programmes – Jess Beitzel
		Good numbers in the Junior Program which has just started.  ACTION - all riders in program will have licences (KIDZ) upgraded to Gold. Cost to be covered by CACT \$1000 grant for Juniors. Peter to contact CA to determine cost and arrange upgrade.
		Track bikes - \$100 fee to hire bikes and must be returned by December 1st. Loan is for those looking to ride NJTS. Bikes to be returned in preparation for track re-opening in December and potential demand from new riders. Stressed that these bikes are really for beginners wanting to try track cycling, and not for riders looking to race the entire season.
		Goulburn Track cycling - no dates confirmed, but looks like they will run Saturday evening training.
