7.	Summer Crits (SC)	SC welcomed and introduced Ella Bloor (and Jennifer Kay). They were invited to discuss prizemoney. Ella Bloor (and Jennifer Kay) outlined the challenges of the current model. General and positive discussion followed. The outcomes of this included future planning for crits and to adopt the following: • Open Grades A - D. Men and women select the grade that best suits them. No separate men's or women's grades. • Open E will be a development grade, where new riders, juniors, and women learn bunch and race craft. If required, a women's bunch will start slightly behind and separate from other riders. No prizemoney for riders in Open E.	Actions 1. Ella Bloor to investigate prizemoney

		 Final dollar amounts for prizemoney haven't yet been set. Prizemoney will be equal across the grades, with the first three riders in each grade receiving prize money, and the first three women in each grade also receiving equal prize money. Where a women's rider is eligible for more than one prize they will receive the prize of greater value. IE If a rider places 2nd overall, and also first woman's rider she would receive the prize for first women's placing only. Ella Bloor will assist with securing women's prize money for next season to achieve this. The committee supported this approach, and invited Ella to join the committee to assist with implementing the points above next season.
