- Neil reported:
  - From 1 November AusCycling going ahead, new licences published, member and club FAQs up, some considerations for interstate riders, and CNSW are in negotiations to work with AusCycling
  - Numbering system NS provided overview of numbering system. All ACT clubs to be allocated a numbering scheme, all riders to be issued with 'season' numbers, timing RFID chips, and frame plates etc.
  - CACT negotiating with SFP re kangaroos and kangaroo management, kangaroo incident form to be completed every time a kangaroo neutralizes a race etc
  - CACT had met with Greens and Labour ahead of election. Good working relationship in place.
  - NS provided an overview of CACT (AusCycling ACT's)5 point plan: Nth Sth rd @ SFP, crit extension, 12km road circuit, pavilion for the runners, a grand stand events area. However, the most pressing need is now a temporary road to join Uriarra Rd to crit course.
  - Some commentary that that route may not make it all the way to the crit course.
     May exit early. TBC
  - AusCycling office in the ACT. NS full time. 3.5 FTE staff. Madeleine has resigned.
  - COVID requirements –as at 9th
     October. Must have electronic tracing register, incl spectators. The Clubs are
