AusCycling Club Forum #1 Summary

Thank you to those who attended the first Club Forum of 2023, where we shared an update on public liability insurance and the challenges we face with increasing premiums.

We had a great turnout with over 150 Club, State and Territory Advisory Council, Board and Staff representatives logging in to be part of the conversation. And my sense is that if we get the Club email contacts updated and have the right topics up for discussion (we're going to be guided by you here), participation will grow throughout the year and the forums will be a key part of our joint decision making, which is exciting.

But before we can do that, acknowledging that there can be issues with generic email address and Mail Chimp (our eDM platform), it appears that there are a lot of outdated Club contacts sitting in Tidy HQ. So, over the next four weeks, we'll be working with the State Operations Managers and Membership team to ensure that we have not only the correct 'Official Club Contact', but also the correct Club President and Secretary contact details.

We're committed to enhancing communication with Clubs and that starts with having the right contact details.

Calling for Expressions of Interest to be part of the Club Insurance Advisory Group

The current challenges we face with respect to the AusCycling insurance program impacts all of us.

12 months ago, the AusCycling Finance Audit and Risk (FAR) Committee established the Insurance Workgroup. The group consists of FAR members and insurance specialists and was established to inform our approach to the AusCycling insurance program. The first

The next piece of work is more comprehensive and will investigate the member value proposition; the structure of the insurance program; managing risk and optimizing data and insights (with respect to the insurance program).

To support and inform the work of the AusCycling Insurance Workgroup, and the recommendations that are ultimately put forward to the AusCycling Board, we are establishing a Club Advisory Group to ensure the voice of the Clubs is ever-present as we consider how to create not only a sustainable insurance program, but one that is valued by Clubs and members alike.

Purpose / Role

 The Club Advisory Group will be a 'sounding board / reference group' for the AusCycling Insurance Workgroup.

Commitment / Term

- We anticipate an initial term of six months with the option to extend pending the progress of the AusCycling Insurance Workgroup.
- The detailed project plan is still to be finalised; however, as a guide we anticipate one, two where required, meeting each month.

Group composition

- 8 to 10 members.
- Members of the advisory group will be drawn from AusCycling Clubs and will represent the various disciplines BMX, Mountain Bike, Road, and Track.
- Insurance, legal, risk and compliance skills will be prioritised in the appointment process, as will ensuring gender diversity within the group.
